Port Pass Use Regulations

Québec Port Authority is giving you a Port Pass which allows you to enter its territory. Possessing and using this Pass is a privilege granted by QPA and its users. The holder of a Port Pass must understand the responsibilities coming with this privilege, responsibilities in link with QPA's regulations as well as federal regulations.

Port Pass

The Port Pass is the document that allows its owner to enter QPA's territory exclusively for working purpose.

- No person shall provide access to or assist another person to enter a secured area. The Port Pass holder who is entering QPA's
 territory by a gate should make sure that every Port Pass holder in his vehicle passes his Pass in front of the card reader. If one
 or more person doesn't have a Port Pass, the vehicle must use the <u>visitor</u> line or identify the visitors by using the telephone at
 the gate.
- The holder of a Port Pass that has been lost or stolen shall immediately report its loss or theft to QPA or the operator of the marine facility.
- 3. A person shall not provide false information for the purpose of obtaining a Port Pass, otherwise his request will be permanently denied.
- 4. A person shall not use a Port Pass except while in the performance of their duties.
- 5. The holder of a Port Pass shall return it to QPA's representative or the marine facility when
 - (a) the holder ceases to work at the marine facility;
 - (b) the holder otherwise ceases to require the Port Pass.
- 6. A person shall surrender on demand a Port Pass in their possession to QPA's representative or the marine facility.
- 7. No person shall:
 - a) loan or give a Port Pass that was issued to one person to another person;
 - b) alter or otherwise modify a Port Pass;
 - c) have or use a Port Pass that was issued to another person;
 - d) use a counterfeit a Port Pass;
 - e) make or reproduce a copy of a Port Pass.
- 8. Please signal any incident to the Harbour Master's Office at 418-648-3556.

MARSEC LEVEL 1 - Regular situation – The level for which minimum security requirements are required to be implemented in accordance with the approved security plan or approved security procedures.

MARSEC LEVEL 2 - Heightened risk – The level for which additional security requirements are required to be implemented as a result of heightened risk in accordance with the approved security plan or approved security procedures.

MARSEC LEVEL 3 - Probable or imminent threat – The level for which additional security requirements are required to be implemented as a result of a security threat that is probable or imminent, whether or not the specific target is identified, in accordance with the approved security plan or approved security procedures.

I agree to indemnify the Quebec Port Authority for all damages to its property. I agree to reimburse or to be guarantor for any claims whatsoever against the Quebec Port Authority for all bodily injuries and for property damages within the Port limits.

Except in the event of serious or intentional fault on the part of the **Authority**, it shall not be liable for any damage to the client's property. Unless fault is established on the part of the **Authority**, it shall not be liable for any damage and/or harm to persons and/or for their death on the premises, howsoever caused, whether by *force majeure* or otherwise.

The applicant accepts that the Quebec Port Authority can give the information contained on this Port Pass request and/or any information concerning the use of the Port Pass to the Port's users concerned by this information (employer or company sponsoring this request) and who is making a written request. The Port Authority is the sole judge of the legitimacy of such request.

The applicant must send a digitalized picture with his request at poste.controle@portquebec.ca. The applicant who cannot proceed electronically must ask for an appointment, between 7 am and 3 pm on working days, with the Control Center by calling 418-266-0760 ext. 5798.
